# Pre-Construction Notification

## Dysart Road and Thunderbird Road Improvement Project

**Project Description**

The City of El Mirage in partnership with the City of Surprise has contracted with DCS Contracting to construct roadway improvements at Dysart Road and Thunderbird Road/Waddell Road.

New roadway improvements include: widening Waddell Road extending 900 feet to the west of the intersection with Dysart Road, widening Thunderbird Road extending 1,000 feet east of the intersection of Dysart Road to 129<sup>th</sup> Avenue; widening Dysart Road to tie-into the existing improvements approximately 700 feet to the north of Thunderbird Road to Via Camille, and 2,800 feet to the south of Thunderbird Road at Soledad Street; relocation of utilities currently located in the new roadway alignment including the 69kV APS power lines; installation of new curb, gutter, sidewalk and pavement, which will match the existing conditions in Dysart Road and Thunderbird Road, traffic signal, and railroad improvements including gates on all four approaches to the intersection.

**Project Schedule**

The contract allows 270 days for construction of the Roadway Improvement Project. Beginning Monday, October 26, 2009, the contractor will begin relocation of the existing utilities; this work is scheduled to take approximately one month. Upon completion of the utility work, the contractor will begin grading the roadway in preparation for installation of new curb, gutter, and sidewalk. Followed by final grading, and installation of the new pavement.

Roadway improvements in the intersection of Thunderbird Road and Dysart Road are anticipated to begin in late January 2010, and will require detailed coordination with BNSF Railway.

**Traffic Restrictions**

Traffic will be restricted adjacent to the contractor's work area. However, one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Left hand turns may be temporarily restricted. Please expect some delays and use caution when traveling through the construction area, and observe construction barricading and signage at all times.

We realize that this project will cause some inconveniences, however the long-term roadway and sidewalk improvements will greatly benefit travel through this area.
